Policy Statement #17–10 Collaboration Involving the Use of Animals Faculty of Science, Mahidol University–Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (MUSC–IACUC)

All research activities performed under the direction of MUSC personnel at a non-MUSC facility should comply with MUSC–IACUC policies and procedures. Anyone performing animal research must follow their home-institution's policies, procedures and guidelines, as well as those of the host-institution, with the institution that owns the animals maintaining primary oversight responsibility.

- If work with live animals is being done at a MUSC-CAF, MUSC-IACUC is accountable for ensuring that the work being conducted on the project meets all applicable regulations and MUSC-IACUC policies regarding the humane care and use of animals. Therefore, such projects are subject to review and approval by the MUSC-IACUC.
- 2. Wherever possible and appropriate, MUSC-IACUC will accept the review and approval of the offsite institution's IACUC or comparable regulatory committee upon submission of appropriate documentation demonstrating the support and collaboration of the offsite institution.
- 3. Wherever animals are housed, the home institution will be responsible for the day-to-day animal welfare. In case of adverse events, principal investigator should include the inspection reports in the Annual Review to MUSC–IACUC.
